NGX Crude – Required Network Changes

29 January 2010

This is a notice for NGX crude customers describing IT changes they must make in order to continue accessing the NGX Crude Trading Platform following upcoming network upgrades at NGX.

Below is an outline of the changes required. **These changes need to be completed by March 21, 2010** by your IT department or technical contact.

As part of this change modifications may be required to your firewall or proxy server setup. The NGX Crude Trading Application (formerly NTP) **does not** work behind proxy servers. Please forward this table outlining the changes to the appropriate IT contact in your organization.

The old DNS Names and IP will be retired on March 20, 2010. The new IPs and DNS names must be setup in your firewall by March 21, 2010.
