



Nomination Process Change at all TCPL Locations

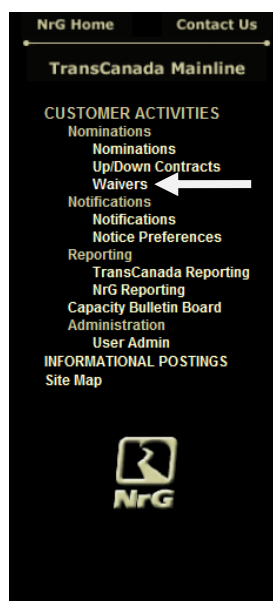
Effective July 21, 2015 NGX will be implementing a change to our nomination process for the following TCPL - Mainline locations:

Locations Include:		
Chippawa	Empress	Iroquois
East Hereford	Enbridge CDA	Niagara
Emerson 1	Enbridge EDA	St Clair
Emerson 2	GMI EDA	Suffield 2

In an effort to make the nomination process more efficient and timely for our customers, NGX will now be submitting a **daily** nomination file upload once trading closes at 10:30 am MST. The upload will include all nominations for the locations listed above.

In conjunction with this change, we are encouraging all customers to set up an electronic Waiver for NGX through the NRG Highway site (www.nrghighway.com). This will allow customers to automatically acknowledge Title Transfer nominations submitted by NGX, and eliminate the need to enter their nominations manually or accept daily changes. Customers who choose not to set up a Waiver will still need to manually nominate and accept changes each day.

To set up a Waiver, login to the [NRG Highway](http://www.nrghighway.com). Under Customer Activities, choose **Waivers**.



In the new window, choose **ICE NGX Canada Inc.** as the Waiver Company and **TCPL** as the Service Provider. Click New to add the Waiver, then Save.
