



Force Majeure Declaration at TCO Trading Location

February 25, 2015

Due to certain events that occurred on February 14, 2015, Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (TCO) accepted a force majeure declaration from Markwest Sherwood Plant. As a result, Natural Gas Exchange, Inc. ("**NGX**") is hereby notifying all contracting parties of NGX, pursuant to the terms of the NGX Contracting Party's Agreement (the "**CPA**"), that NGX has also recognized a force majeure event in effect for all NGX-cleared natural gas transactions traded for **Gas Day February 14th, 2015** at the Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (TCO) trading location.

As a result of the foregoing, this notice serves as a Force Majeure Declaration, pursuant to Section 11 of Schedule "J" of the Contracting Party's Agreement (the "**CPA**").

Subject to further notification, NGX has determined at this time that this Force Majeure Declaration will reflect the reduction of delivery obligations for each counterparty, as declared by the pipeline operator.

The Force Majeure Declaration has resulted in a suspension of contracting party obligations to NGX to the amount reduced by the pipeline operator for each NGX counterparty.

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Notice Text

On February, 15, 2015, Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (TCO) posted Notice ID 24341008 to provide notification of a power outage due to high winds that occurred on February 14, 2015 at the Markwest Sherwood plant. Markwest has since declared Force Majeure for this event. Due to the extenuating circumstances that were beyond the control of our shippers, TCO will waive any Critical Day Transportation and Storage penalties for Saturday, February 14, 2015 related to this Force Majeure event.

Previous Notice (24341008):

Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (TCO) received notification late yesterday of a power

outage due to high winds at the Markwest Sherwood plant. As a result of the outage, supply into the TCO system from the Sherwood plant was reduced. Due to the extreme weather and market conditions, TCO was required to balance these markets with the supply and was therefore forced to reduce markets for ID2 on February 14, 2015. Currently, receipts are increasing and no cuts are expected for ID1, but TCO will continue to monitor flow for the balance of today, February 15, 2015. TCO will post additional information by 2:30 CT. TCO is reviewing the associated impact of these cuts and will let customers know as soon as possible.
